The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) would like to notify you of an upcoming guiderail replacement project in your community. Project Identification Number (PIN) 9TGD24, Contract #D265116, will address guiderails along approximately 2 miles of State Route 34 in the town of Barton and approximately 4 miles of State Route 79 in the town of Richford.

This project is scheduled to be completed during the 2024 construction season. Guiderail replacements will begin approximately 0.3 miles south of Talmadge Hill Road and end approximately 1 mile north of the Old State Route 34. On State Route 79, project begins approximately ¾ mile east of West Hill Rd and ends near Robinson Hollow Road. Project location maps are enclosed for your reference.

During construction, travelers should expect shoulder closures and temporary lane closures controlled via flaggers. Access to driveways may temporarily be controlled via flaggers during construction. No permanent alterations to driveway openings are anticipated as part of the guiderail replacements.
